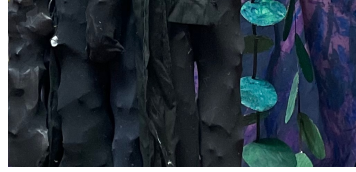


## Year 1

Secondly, they had to make hanging trees using tights, filled with stuffing from old duvets and cushions.



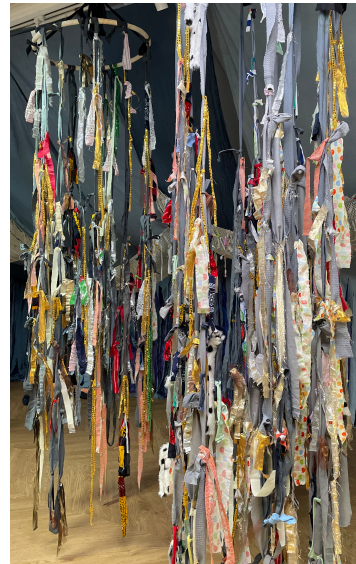
Year 1 Top: hanging trees;

Every pupil in the school has collaborated to create this immersive art installation – comprising sculptures, wall hangings and stained glass-looking windows – made entirely from recycled materials

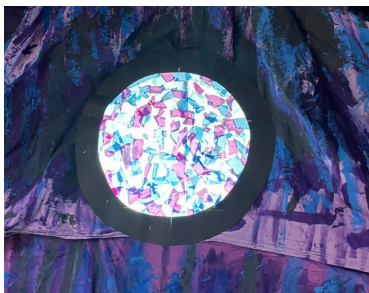

## Kindergarten
